Biodiversity Poster competition

The General Secretariat of the Convention on Biological Diversity and the Consulate General of the Republic of Korea in Montreal are presenting a conference, on June 15 and 16, on the occasion of the 30th anniversary of the Convention entitled: *30 years of biodiversity: a legacy from Rio to future generations*. The event will take place in a hybrid format, at the house of sustainable development and at the biosphere. It will be an opportunity to showcase the work of students from colleges and universities through a poster competition after which the best ones will be exhibited as part of the event.

Selected presentations will be exposed throughout the conference. Their authors will be invited to participate to the symposium and present their posters to the participants.

Selected poster will get:

- A free invitation to participate to the conference;
- The meeting of scientific, governmental and social actors of the sector;
- Networking with the other students involved.

Anyone interested is invited to submit their poster proposal by April 29, 2022, at 5 p.m., respecting the rules below.

Instructions for the presentation of the poster

Send the poster proposal to (fortier.pierre-luc.2@courrier.uqam.ca) indicating in the subject of the email “Poster proposal” before 5 p.m. on April 29, 2022.

1. Format

- a. Word ou PDF en pièce jointe au courriel
- b. Landscape format
- c. Maximum size 180 cm wide and 120 cm high

2. Required content

- a. Name and affiliation of the authors
- b. Summary of the problem
- c. The project's objectives
- d. Summary of the methodology
- e. Main results or, in the context of an ongoing project, preliminary results

Selection criteria

The scientific committee, made from university researchers, will determined the accepted submission before May 1, 2022. The committee will evaluate the posters according to the following criteria: creativity, depth of the project or research, balance and aesthetics as well as the link with the theme of the conference.
